

## Varsity Boys Track & Field Places Second

Improving upon last year's sixth place finish, the Varsity Boys Track & Field team placed second out of 25 teams at the St. Marks' BVU Invitational on Saturday, Mar 26, 2011. The team was led by first place finishes in the 400m (Dane Earl), 1600m (Garrett McCurrach), 110m High Hurdles (Jarod Haynes), and High Jump (Jarod Haynes). Athletes placing 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> scored points for the team. Others scoring for the team included the 4x800m Relay Team (2<sup>nd</sup>-Ethan Cummings, Drew Morgan, Chris Vorgert, Garrett McCurrach), Jarod Haynes (3<sup>rd</sup>-100m, 3<sup>rd</sup>-200m, 3<sup>rd</sup>-Long Jump), Drew Morgan (4<sup>th</sup>-2000m Steeplechase), and Dane Earl (4<sup>th</sup>-200m, 7<sup>th</sup>-100m).

The Varsity Girls Team finished 14<sup>th</sup> out of 25 teams. Scoring for the team were Allie Vinson (3<sup>rd</sup>-400m), Dillon Duchesne, (5<sup>th</sup>-300m hurdles, 6<sup>th</sup>-100m hurdles), and Janell Kolins (7<sup>th</sup>-Discus).
