## Players:

1. As a representative of HSAA and homeschoolers in general, exhibit excellent behavior, and be an excellent example to all others (this applies to opposing teams, all players, coaches, officials, and hotel staff).
2. Ensure that your parent, team parent, or coach is aware of where you are at all times.
3. Exhibit appropriate behavior at the hotel and the gymnasiums, which means:
  - Be respectful of the facilities. We are guests.
  - No running in the halls.
  - No playing in elevators.
  - No horseplay.
  - No vandalism (any vandalism is the financial responsibility of the player/parent).
4. Do not enter the room of a member of the opposite sex (other than family members).
5. Observe curfew set by the commissioner (in room by 10 pm).
6. Exhibit appropriate behavior while in the lobby and dining areas of the hotel.
7. Attend all team or organizational meetings, if any. Any exceptions must be discussed with the coach ahead of time.

**Note:** Violation of the rules will result in disciplinary action at the discretion of the coach. Discipline may include no playing time, but in the worst situation, it could result in a player being sent home at the player's expense.

**Parents:**

1. Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, fans, and officials at all games.
2. Be aware of where your child is at all times.
3. Ensure that your player(s) and children follow the above guidelines for hotel and gymnasium conduct.
4. Ensure that your player(s) and children follow the curfew set by the commissioner (in room by 10pm).
5. Help your player make team or organizational meetings, or make other arrangements, if necessary.
6. Advocate a sports environment for your child that is free of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, and abusive language, and refrain from their use while you are around the children.
7. Resolve any issues with your coach first. If necessary, contact Coach Davis, HSAA Commissioner.
8. If you have issues with the NCHBC Tournament staff, planning, brackets, seeding, locations, etc., voice your opinion to Coach Davis and not to the NCHBC staff. Complaints must go through the proper channels.
