

HSAA Letter Jacket Q&A

Q. Who is eligible to purchase a jacket?

A. Any high school athlete (9th–12th grade) that has participated on an HSAA high school sports team may purchase a letter jacket.

Q. How do I order a jacket?

A. Download the order form from the website, and mail the form and check to the address on the form. Your team will have a sizing session, or you may go to Sports Distributors, 580 W. Arapaho, Richardson (972-235-8223), to size your jacket.

Q. When are orders placed?

A. Typically, two orders are placed each year: Sept/Oct and January.

Q. What is the cost of a letter jacket?

A. The price may change from year to year based on the cost from the supplier. The order form is updated each year and will have the current cost.

Q. What comes on the jacket?

A. The cost of the jacket will include the “H” chenille letter on the front left side. A sport insert will be built into the “H”. If you participate in more than one sport, you can have more than one insert added. Since the insert is built into the “H”, they cannot be added. You can purchase a new “H” or a sport pin for any new sport you may participate in later.

Q. Can I add patches to my jacket?

A. The HSAA order form does allow you to order two patches: 3 ½ inch jersey number patches and “Class of 20__” to indicate your graduation year. These can be ordered with the jacket or at a later date. Patches are ordered at the same time as jackets in order to achieve a minimum purchase quantity. If a minimum quantity is not met, the patch cost will increase.

Q. Can my name be added to my jacket?

A. Yes. Names can be stitched on the front or on the back. You can also have a chenille custom name patch made. If you are interested in any of these, you will need to contact Sports Distributors before you turn in your order form to HSAA. These can also be added at any later date. Each chenille name patch is a special order.

Q. Are there other patches I can add to my jacket?

A. By wearing your HSAA letter jacket, you are representing our organization. We ask that any additions to your jacket be appropriate and applicable to your sport. Examples of other patches could be 1st Place Nationals 2009, MVP 2011, etc. HSAA *does* reserve the right to ask for the removal of any offensive, false, or inappropriate additions. If you’re not certain, please ask.

Q. How do I earn pins and service bars to wear on my jacket?

A. HSAA awards each athlete with a JV and/or a Varsity pin to wear on the letter jacket during their high school years. One service bar is award yearly to an athlete for participation in one or more HSAA sport.. These bars and pins may be handed out at end-of-season events or at the All Sports Banquet.
