

3-Pt Shooting Contest Registration and Rules

Online Registration

All teams (including 10U) may enter up to 2 participants in the contest (**Note:** Shooters are eligible to compete in one division only).

Only **coaches** are to pre-register each team's competitors (no more than 2 per team) through [Online Registration](#). After pre-registering the competitors, you may substitute a player at the tournament table next to Court 8 on Friday. Do not register a substitute competitor through the online system.

All players will shoot three racks of balls (top of the key and both corners) for a total of 15 shots in 30 seconds. Immediately following the first round, the top shooters of each combined age bracket will participate in the 2nd round, and each player will shoot 10 shots. **NOTE:** The 3-Pt Shooting Contest staff have discretion in determining the number of players that advance to the 2nd round, with no more than 10 advancing from each combined age bracket. After the 2nd round, the Top 3 shooters from each combined age bracket advance to the finals on Saturday. **NOTE:** There are two combined age brackets, or divisions, for boys and girls (**10U/12U/14U & 16U/18U**).

Preliminaries:

Preliminaries take place on Court 8 on Friday, February 10, at the following window of time (**Note:** All times are approximate.)

10U/12U/14U Boys and Girls: Round 1: 1:15 pm – 2:00 pm. Round 2: 2:00 to 2:15 pm

16U/18U Boys and Girls: Round 1: 2:15 pm – 3:00 pm. Round 2: 3:00 to 3:15 pm

IMPORTANT: If the player has a game during his/her age group's designated time, talk to the staff to "take a turn" before or after the game is complete (or even halftime of shooter's game). Please communicate the conflict to the staff. If necessary, a player may participate any time within the 1:15 to 3:15 pm window. Failure to show up and/or communicate conflicts will result in disqualification.

A table will be set up from 1:00 pm to 1:15 pm on Friday next to Court 8 for late-entry check-in or substitution. (Check-in is not needed if the shooter's name is already pre-registered through online registration.)

Finals:

The Top 3 players in each combined age bracket will advance to the Finals of the 3-pt shooting contest on Saturday, February 11, at the Fieldhouse. The finals will include a 10U/12U/14U division (total of 6 contestants) and a 16U/18U division (total of 6 contestants) for both boys and girls. Finals will take place at or around 5:45 pm on Saturday, Court 1, after the 18U Girls Championship game. Trophies will be awarded for:

- 10U/12U/14U Girls Champion
- 10U/12U/14U Boys Champion
- 16U/18U Girls Champion
- 16U/18U Boys Champion
